2019 Napa Valley Estate Sauvignon Blanc

100% Sauvignon Blanc

91 Points, James Suckling

This refreshing Sauvignon Blanc offers light pale straw hues with glimmering hints of green. Yellow grapefruit, green lime and passionfruit aromas mingle with a subtle touch of anise. In the cellar, minimal intervention yields a vibrant freshness on the palate with flavors of pink grapefruit and lime zest zinging through the finish to create a vibrant and powerful sauvignon blanc.

2019 Dollarhide Estate Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc

A brightly colored wine with yellow and green hues. Citrus notes of lemon, key lime and grapefruit lead to aromas of kiwi, pear with a hint of tropical fruit, anise, and wet gravel. The flavors follows suit; green lime, grapefruit, grapefruit zest and kiwi dominate with a subtle thread of toasty French oak rounding out the textured mouthfeel balancing with crisp acidity.

2018 Napa Valley Estate Cabernet Sauvignon

87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Petit Verdot, 3% Cabernet Franc, 2% Malbec, 2% Merlot | 100% French Oak (22% new) for 20 months

92 points James Suckling, 90 points, Jeb Dunnock;

Opulent purple and red hues present this wine. Cassis, black plum and dark raspberry aromas combine with anise and subtle vanilla, evidence of the toasted oak maturation. Juicy blackberry and black currant flavors mingle with dark cocoa, black licorice, espresso and subtle toasted oak. This textured and elegantly structured cabernet sauvignon exhibits a velvety tannin finish.

2015 Napa Valley Estate Élu

74% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot, 7% Malbec, 5% Cabernet Franc, 4% Petit Verdot | 100% French Oak (43% new) for 19 months, 3% Barrel Fermentation | 3,539 cases

Élu presents with deep shades of reds and purples. Aromas of dark fruit, blackberry and black plum combine with elements of espresso, vanillin and molasses, as well as notes of smoky oak and dusty terroir. Flavors of dark plum and cassis follow with anise and toasted barrel attributes. This red blend offers a finely textured silky structure with density and a graceful appeal.
